ABOUT THE GOLF COURSE



Eagles Pride Golf Course Joint Base Lewis McChord Tacoma, Washington

A treasure of the Pacific Northwest nestled in the shadow of magnificent Mount Rainier, Eagles Pride Golf Course is one of the best courses in Western Washington. It was voted in the top 10 of military golf courses by *Travel and Leisure* magazine. It's located just nine miles from the heart of Lacey, less than seven miles from Hawks Prairie and just around the corner from Joint Base Lewis McChord and DuPont and is open to the public.

Course

With its impressive design and perfectly groomed layout, this 27-hole championship course features exceptional greens, manicured fairways and forgiving rough with tee boxes designed for all levels of golfers. The tournament will be held on the main 18-hole course.

Driving Range

Complementing the course, golfers have a year-round practice facility that features 10 covered hitting areas with light and heat. To complete the ultimate golfing experience, a driving range with "natural grass" hitting areas is included. There will be driving range balls included for players.

Driving Directions:

From I-5 (Heading North)

Take exit #116. Turn left when you reach the end of the off ramp. Cross the overpass, and the golf course is on the right.

From I-5 (Heading South)

Take exit #116. At the end of the off ramp turn right, the golf course is on the right.
